## JOINT RECYCLING COMMITTEE

October 15, 2012

The regular meeting of the Joint Recycling Committee was called to order at 5:48 p.m. in the Albany Village Hall, 206 North Water Street, Albany WI by Chairperson Kim Blumer. Members present were: Blumer, Peggy Boeck, Rod Sutherland, Robb Spangler, Keith Hobson and David Dowden [Ex-Offico]. Also present was: Jon Runaas, Dan Blumer and Tim Bolhuis from Pellitteri.

Proof of posting was verified.

MINUTES: Motion by Boeck, seconded by Hobson, to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. Carried.

PELLITTERI: Tim Bolhuis came to speak about the different types of dumpsters available to the Village. After much discussion, asking Dowden, Blumer and Runaas what would work best, we came to the conclusion to keep the six 8 yard dumpsters we have, with the addition of one 20 yard dumpster to be used only for large items such as couches, recliner chairs, mattreses, and other large items. The cost would be \$185 per pick up. If it is only used for this purpose, it should not have to be dumped very frequently. The dumpster will be covered with a tarp in-between uses to keep down the water weight absorbed into the cushions.

Motion by Hobson, seconded by Sutherland, to add a 20 yard dumpster to the six 8 yard dumpsters at a cost of \$185 per dump, only when full or requested to be dumped. Carried.

CONCERNS OF RECYCLING WORKERS: Dowden is concerned about people dumping garbage when no one is there or when the gates are open for the trucks to pick up the dumpsters. Everyone thought that if garbage is being dumped at this time, it would be best to give a key to the Pellitteri driver so the gates are not left open while unattended. Hobson also suggested we put a sign that states the center is under video surveillance.

ANNOUNCEMENT AND FUTURE AGENDA ITEMS: Runaas needs to replace the non-working light as requested in previous meeting, needs to fix the gates, and patch the roof.

ADJOURNMENT: Motion by Sutherland, seconded by Boeck, to adjourn. Carried.
